**There are three ways to deal with any technological advancement: Avoidance; Augmentation; Acceleration.** (FaithDrivenEntrepreneur.com)

- **Avoidance** is often driven by: Lack of understanding; Fear of change; Deficiency of technical skills. These people reject anything new and like to stick to what they know.
- **Augmentation** is using what is available to our benefit. Ethical AI sees gains in augmentation: How can AI reduce the burden of repetitive tasks? How can AI capitalize on the experience and expertise of your workforce? How can AI make work more fulfilling and meaningful?
- **Acceleration** is getting involved in the politics and policy surrounding AI and becoming an architecture of the platform, not just using it but forming it.

## The key to using AI is to see it as a “tool”

- **Check** – make sure you are formatting questions/prompts correctly
- **Test** – verify any citations, Bible verses, and links to make sure they are correct
- **Validate** – don’t just copy, understand the output and use it wisely

## How should Christians respond to AI?

- We should be mindful about personal data and data generated by daily activity should be shielded from AI systems.
- We should learn how AI is used and develop the skills to utilize Ai as well as being able recognize when AI is being used.
- We should be actively involved in the discussion and process by government of data gathering, monitoring, and protection measures.
- We should be people of high integrity only using AI as a tool.
